Triana Energy Completes Full ISO Recertification

Triana Energy has successfully completed a full recertification of its Health, Safety and Environmental Management Systems according to the standards of ISO-14001 and OHSAS-18001. On the five-year anniversary of its initial award, a comprehensive audit conducted by Det Norske Veritas has been completed and recertification awarded.
